Groomers will be responsible for their dog's behaviour. A proper secure leash is mandatory. Holding pens and cages are provided. Please tell us in advance if your dog has issues with other dogs. Difficult dogs you find challenging to groom <u>are</u> permitted as the workshop covers tips on getting these dogs to relax and co-operate. There will be regular breaks for groomers and dogs on the day. **TOOLS:** Bring Grooming tools including Scissors, Thinning shears, Clippers, Combs Blades and anything else you would normally use to groom these breeds

PPE: Grooming apron or smock and fully enclosed comfortable shoes, mask if necessary and any other PPE you require to ensure your safety.
