

## Animal Care, Animal Management – TAFE WSI, Richmond, NSW

Offering Certificate II and Certificate II in Animal Studies, TAFE is part of the Nationally Accredited RTO system and sets you up for Boarding, Shelter work, Quarantine, Animal Parks, Research Centres and Pet Shops.

As well as basic animal care, these courses include OHS, environmental sustainability, breeding, first aid, hygiene and infection control, reception services, provision of advice and basic veterinary nursing. There are also a number of elective units available that will assist if you are looking toward a grooming career.

The courses include highly flexible study options and really low fees, making them a cost effective way to get a qualification in the pet industry.

With teachers drawn from industry many of these units are relevant, practical and useful no matter what type of pet business you are in.

TAFE also increasingly runs a number of short courses and workshops that will allow you to hone your skills or use as a refresher.
