We are located 17 kilometres from the M7. Take the Richmond Road exit. (Richmond Road becomes Blacktown Road as you approach Richmond.) Look for the blue TAFE signs at the corner of Blacktown Road and Campus Drive just before Richmond.

Or, take a train to East Richmond station and then a pleasant 20 minute stroll down Bourke Street, through the UWS gates, turn left at the sign through the cow paddocks into Richmond TAFE.
